CANCER SCREENING:

Regular screening is important, but is your responsibility to have screening procedures scheduled and coordinated by your primary care physician. As subspecialists, our practices are not organized in a fashion to allow us to adequately perform this service. Please forgive us for any inconvenience this may cause. A variety of organizations have developed screening recommendations, including, but not limited to the National Institute of Health (NIH) and the American Cancer Society (ACS). Make sure to discuss these issues with your primary care physician at your next visit and let that office know ahead of time that adequate time for a consultation will need to be scheduled.
